REGULATIONS

INTRODUCTION

LIAF (London International Animation Festival) is working closely with PooP (Poo Productions Ltd), to jointly promote awareness about sanitation and hygiene issues in developing countries. The competition will form its own programme within the LIAF festival in September and will also be screened during events relating to Global Handwashing Day (15 Oct 09) and World Toilet Day (19 Nov 09).

KEY DATES

All films entered for the competition must arrive at the LIAF office by no later than midnight on 15th May 2009.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

All films must meet the following requirements and specifications to be eligible:

1. Films must be 60 seconds to 5 minutes in total running time, including titles and credits
2. All films must contain at least 70% of animated content.
3. Films must be based around the subject of sanitation and/or hygiene
4. If invited for screening films must be available to us in broadcast quality
5. Non-English language works must include English subtitles
6. LIAF & PooP will reserve the right to refuse any entry to its competition, at their own discretion. Submitted material must not contain obscene, unlawful or objectionable material.
7. By entering, filmmakers agree to LIAF and PooP showcasing their films during and after the competition.

SHORTLISTING & JUDGING

An internal LIAF/PooP selection committee will shortlist 15 films. Shortlisted films will be judged by film industry professionals who will join the LIAF Director to review and award the best film. All shortlisted entrants will be notified by email.

LIAF and PooP reserve the right to select fewer than 15 films for the shortlist if, in its sole discretion, it does not receive a sufficient number of eligible and qualified entries.

IF YOUR WORK IS SELECTED

If your film is shortlisted or selected by LIAF/PooP, we may get in touch to request extra film stills, a director photo and biography, and interviews with the director or production team.

Please note that by entering, filmmakers grant LIAF and PooP the rights to use footage, stills and/or titles, and information from the film for promotional purposes for a mutually agreed period.

LIAF and PooP will seek to identify additional platforms to promote participating films beyond the LIAF festival.

THIRD PARTY RIGHTS & CLEARANCES

All films must be the original work of the entrant and must not infringe upon the copyrights, trademarks, rights of privacy, publicity or other intellectual property or other rights of any person or entity. If the film contains any material or elements that are not owned by the entrant and/or which are subject to the rights of third parties, the entrant is responsible for obtaining, prior to the submission of the film, any and all releases and consents necessary to permit use and exploitation of the film.

ENTRANT PERMISSIONS

By participating in this Competition, entrants agree that both during the competition period and following its completion, LIAF and PooP are authorised to display the films on LIAF and PooP websites, on any and all other media in connection with the Competition and at events to promote wider awareness of sanitation/hygiene issues.

ACCEPTANCE OF REGULATIONS

By signing the entry form, the participant accepts the terms of the present regulations as stated in this document. The competition is governed and subject to the laws of the United Kingdom. The decisions of LIAF and PooP are final and binding in all matters relating to this Contest.
